



Clement J. "Pete" Feldmann

March 11, 1928 to May 25, 2016

C.J. "Pete" Feldmann, formerly of Saginaw, passed away on May 25, 2016, in Naples, FL. He was supported and surrounded by his loving family. Pete (also known as Clem or Heini) was born in Saginaw in 1928 to Clement and Myrtle (Houlihan) Feldmann. He graduated from Arthur Hill High School in 1946 and was admitted to MIT, but following the sudden death of his father he chose to stay in Saginaw and carry on "Feldmann's Glove & Hosiery" which had been in his family for three generations. In 1952, in a well-planned elopement, he married his high school sweetheart, Mary Theobald (also of Saginaw), at St. Peter's in Rome, Italy. Together they raised Peter, Mark, Mary and Tom. Life took Pete and his family from Saginaw to Rochester, MN, Des Moines, IA, Minneapolis, MN, Asheville, NC, and finally to Naples, FL. Driven by a keen intellect and a voracious mind, a gentle heart with a razor wit, on scales grand and small he was a showman with a sense of style and flair. Ever endearing, his legacy lives on in the hearts and minds of those whose lives he touched. Those left to cherish his memory include his wife, Lael, of Naples, sons Peter (Teri) of Dallas, TX, Mark (Teri) of Des Moines, daughter Mary of Naples, son Tom (Judy Krauseneck) of Naples, and two beloved grandsons, Pete Feldmann of Longmont, CO, and Sean Feldmann of Dallas. He was preceded in death by his wife of 50 years, Mary Theobald Feldmann, in 2003, his parents Clem and Myrtle, his sister, Ann and his brother, Jack.
